Scotland and the Edinburgh Tattoo

Leaving Thursday 18 August 2011 for 5 days / 4 nights

We've combined a superb 4-star hotel with some of Scotland's finest attractions to make this a stunning holiday. Our base is just outside Glasgow, giving easy access to Edinburgh and the Tattoo, Loch Lomond and Scone Palace as well as all the magnificent scenery that Scotland has to offer. Our full itinerary, exclusive visit and hotel makes this a holiday not to miss.

The hotel

The Westerwood Hotel and Golf Resort is set in its own 400 acres of woodland overlooked by the Campsie Fells. The hotel includes a spa with comprehensive leisure facilities, superb restaurants and stylish bedrooms where you can relax in comfort after each day's tour.

Itinerary

Day 1 Thursday – Scotland via Trentham Gardens

Finally, we stop at Tebay where there are independently run services. Once at the hotel there'll be time for you to unwind before dinner.

Day 2 Friday – Scone Palace, Baxters and Glendevon

Scone Palace has a long history and is the place where many Scottish Kings were crowned. Today the Palace is famous for its fine collections of porcelain, clocks and furniture. We'll be shown around the palace and kitchens in an exclusive tour by the head guide, followed by scones and tea. Later we head for Baxters at Blackford, a store described as a shopping experience with textiles, gifts jewellery and, of course, food and soups. The day is rounded off with a tour of Glendevon and the countryside around Kinross.

Day 3 Saturday – Edinburgh and the Royal Military Tattoo

Edinburgh and the Royal Military Tattoo form the centre piece of our holiday. A relaxed start gives you time to explore the sights and shops of Edinburgh before settling down for the early evening performance of the Tattoo. The 2011 event includes performers from around the world as well as the traditional displays which have made this Scotland's top attraction.

Day 4 Sunday – Loch Lomond

After the hustle and bustle of Edinburgh, today is more relaxed with a tour to Loch Lomond. We stop at the village of Luss on the banks of the Loch. Scenes from the television programme 'Take the High Road' were filmed here. We retrace our steps to Antartex Village, this former sheepskin factory now hosts many shops with a Scottish flavour, where you can buy clothing, sheepskin, footwear and whisky. Finally there's an hour-long boat trip on Loch Lomond itself. The loch is reputed to be the largest in the country and also has the largest freshwater island, all surrounded by Scottish grandeur.

Day 5 Monday – Homeward bound

Sadly, we're back on the road South. We'll be stopping again at Tebay, Trentham Gardens and Cherwell Valley to give you time to relax away from the coach.
